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## **How to improve your Inpatient Admissions Observed/Expected (O/E) Ratio**

Your CI Index score takes into account your O/E ratio. Follow the tips below to improve your performance in the Efficiency Performance Metrics (EPM) Program.

### **Document and code chronic conditions**

- Use Patient Opportunity Reports and open care gap data to outreach and schedule patients due for visits
- Consider under-captured diagnoses (e.g. heart failure, chronic kidney disease, diabetes with or without complications) and document with specificity

### **Keep patients out of the Emergency Department (as appropriate)**

- Communicate appropriate ED versus urgent care use with patients, and ways to easily access same-day, in-office care
- Scheduled frequent appointments (in person or telehealth) with high-utilizer and high-risk patients

### **Reduce need for inpatient admissions**

- Refer patients for [MSHP Care Management](#) services
  - Sign up for [clinical event notifications](#) (ADT alerts via text, email or Epic direct message) for ED visits and hospital discharges, and perform timely post discharge follow-up
  - Conduct high-risk patient rounds/reviews for multi-disciplinary high-risk patients

### January Patient Opportunity Reports

Voluntary PCPs and pediatricians in our network received customized patient opportunity reports in their One Drive accounts on January 28. PCPs also received the In-Network Integration Performance Report which includes practice-level measurement of new office visits to CIN specialists in 2025.

These reports include patient-level information on care gaps and high utilizers, and can be used to **identify cohorts of patients that need visits to re-engage in care, close quality care gaps, and/or manage and document chronic conditions**. Please be sure to use these reports for effective patient outreach in Q1.

## Payer Updates

### Cigna expands online precertification access

Enhanced online precertification (i.e. prior authorization) functionality is now live for all users with “Patient Search” entitlement on the [Cigna for Health Care Professionals portal](#).

In addition to checking if precertification is required, you now have access to the following new capabilities:

- Submit precertification requests online
- Draft and save requests before submitting
- Track request status in the precertification dashboard
- Upload supporting documentation
- Download summaries when precertification is not required
- Submit precertification appeals directly in the portal

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## UnitedHealthcare temporarily pauses rejection code 799 for multiple-claim submissions

Due to system rejections of multiple original claims submitted for dates of service from November 1, 2025 to January 15, 2026, UnitedHealthcare paused the requirement to allow those who need additional time the opportunity to update their billing systems.

Please resubmit claims rejected with the 799 code:

- Resubmit a consolidated corrected claim
- Resubmit rejected claims as you would have prior to the change

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## New Centivo claims submission requirements

Effective February 1, 2026, all **837P electronic claims** and **CMS-1500 paper claims** must include:

- Rendering Provider NPI and Taxonomy Code
- Billing Provider NPI and Taxonomy Code

**Claims missing any of these required data elements will be returned for correction and will not be processed until complete information is received.**

### **Why this change?**

Including both the National Provider Institute (NPI) and taxonomy code for rendering and billing providers ensures:

- Proper provider identification
- Accurate application of benefit and reimbursement policies
- Streamlined claims adjudication
